- Facilitate market access: Shorten the route from a Kenyan estate to a Chinese shelf.
- Foster collaboration: Put producers, policymakers, financiers and researchers in the same rooms for three days.
- Promote tea culture: Set Kenya's tea heritage alongside China's, as trade and as culture.
